The Galloway Fisheries Trust (GFT) is an environmental charity (SC 020751) which was established in 1988 following concerns by anglers that the afforestation of much of the Galloway uplands with Sitka spruce had reduced fish stocks. The GFT works to improve all freshwater environments, and the fisheries they support, across most of the region including the Water of App, Bladnoch, Cree, Water of Fleet, Kirkcudbrightshire Dee, Luce, Urr and Border Esk.

The GFT works to restore and maintain aquatic biodiversity, particularly native fish, in South West Scotland by means of practical, responsible and sustainable approaches to land, water and fishery management, based on sound science, for the benefit of the community. We achieve this through providing advice, undertaking research and completing practical works to protect and enhance fish stocks, water quality and habitats.

To keep up to date on GFT works check our 'news' section on the GFT website (www.gallowayfisheriestrust.org), like our Facebook page or follow us on Twitter (@Galloway_FT).

The main focus of our work recently has been:

- Delivering education projects across local schools.
- Controlling a range of invasive non-native plant species including American skunk cabbage and Giant hogweed.
- Investigating the spread of North American signal crayfish and how to reduce their impacts.
- Addressing acidification impacts in the Galloway uplands including restructuring conifer plantations away from sensitive waters and peatland restoration.
- Undertaking habitat improvement works including planting deciduous trees to help cool waters.
- Understanding the coarse fish populations in Loch Ken.
- Ensuring renewable schemes (windfarms and hydro) do not affect surrounding fish stocks.

Peatland is an important wet habitat across much of Galloway. These habitats are important for regulating water flows, trapping pollutants and storing carbon. When they are degraded through being drained, before being planted with conifers, they will release carbon and stored pollutants which can cause acidification in surrounding watercourses and kill fish. Local scientific evidence shows that peatland restoration is

required to improve pH levels in many Galloway river headwaters. Identifying suitable sites and completing peatland restoration (through blocking drains or re-profiling eroding peat haggs) is a priority work area for GFT and essential to return fish back to the uplands of Galloway. We work closely with the Crichton Carbon Centre and Peatland Action (SNH) on these projects.

To undertake our annual programme GFT have to raise around £250,000 each year (we receive no government core funding). The Dinner Auction is an important fundraising event for GFT and we would like to thank you for your ongoing support that helps us to improve the waters of Dumfries and Galloway for the local communities to enjoy.



Combat Stress is the UK's leading charity for veterans' mental health. For a century we've been helping former servicemen and women deal with issues like post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD), anxiety and depression.

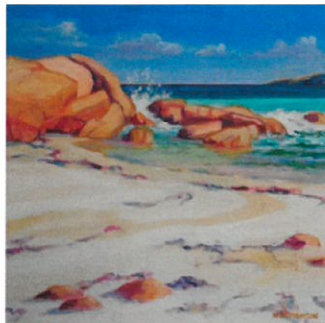

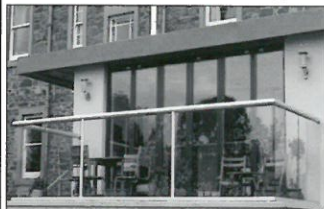
